
May He continue to find us all Faithful...in all our Seasons.

Christianity. It provides youth who are currently in the 10th through 12th grades an opportunity to meet Jesus Christ in a new way as God's grace and love is revealed to them through other believers.

"I am so excited!", said Candy Ogden, Chrysalis Steering Committee Chair. "We've been planning and praying about these flights for the better part of two years and now our efforts are coming true."

The weekend begins on Friday morning and continues through Sunday. The first two Chrysalis flights will be held in November 2015 at Crystal River United Methodist Church. The girl's flight is first from November 6th to 8th, the boy's flight follows from November 13th to 15th. The flights are limited to 20 attendees, called "caterpillars". As the weekend flight progresses, the caterpillars grow into butterflies.


Step 1: Go to www.aldersgateemmaus.org
