Women's Walk #153 April 5 - 8





The Challenge was more successful than any of us ever imagined, raising more than \$5,500 through dozens and dozens of community donations.

Nearly \$2,200 of the total amount came from Sumter County. West Orange placed 2nd with \$1,535 in contributions and Osceola County was 3rd with nearly \$1,300 in Green Agape. The funds raised will be used for Pilgrim and team scholarships and to help support weekend operating expenses.

As winners of the 2017 Challenge, Sumter County and the Tri-County Cluster will receive the coveted "Aldie" Award. The rooster trophy, shown above, will be presented at the next Tri-County Cluster meeting on February 15th.
